

What is COMPETE?

In 2019, tech CEO and STEMatch founder Chris Zannetos gathered executives to evaluate community college tech curricula and students' readiness for entry-level tech jobs. Their conclusion? COMPETE was created to provide those skills and experience - offering companies a diverse, job-ready talent pool while also creating opportunities for the community.
